American Hornbeam Yamadori (Carpinus caroliniana)

These Yamadori, or "collected from nature," Hornbeams have trunks 2 to 4 inches in diameter and are about 18 to 24 inches tall. This workshop is geared towards people with some bonsai knowledge. The focus of the workshop will be on branch selection and wiring to create a good solid bonsai structure.

Dwarf Jade (Portulacaria afra)

A popular tropical tree for beginners. It is a very forgiving tree; it should be grown indoors during the winter and outdoors during the summer. The material for this workshop is compact but with a $\frac{3}{4}$ to 1 inch trunk and 10 inches tall with plenty of branches to work with. The goal of this class is to come away with a tree that has its first initial styling and is on its way to becoming a bonsai.

Field Grown Cork Bark Chinese Elm (Ulmus parvifolia 'Corticosa')

Strong, adaptable, fast growing trees with small textured leaves perfect for the beginner or the experienced student. They have a 1-1/2 inch trunk and are approximately 14 inches tall. Students will learn design principles as well as how to select and prune branches to develop the desired shape for your tree.
